To Town of Ulster Residents,

The Ulster Police Firing Range was established and continues to be used for purpose of training and maintaining the highest level of proficiency for members of the Ulster Police Department, as well as other local law enforcement agencies. With the ever increasing threat on society, as well as law enforcement we want our police officers to be ready and able to protect themselves and others should the need arise.

- Agencies that have permission to use the range besides the Ulster Police Department are: Kingston Police Department, Ulster County Sheriff's Office, Ulster County Probation, Ulster County Law Enforcement Training Group and the New York State Environmental Conservation Police.
- The range is currently utilized approximately 110 to 120 days a year.
- For the safety of officers, a range schedule will not be made public. Hours of operation are Monday thru Friday 9am – 5pm. The hours of 1pm – 9pm are limited to the fall months of September, October, November and December.
- Weekend and after hour use are only permitted with the permission of the Chief of Police.
- Use of the range is only done under the direction of a certified police firearms instructor.
- Residents are requested that if they hear or see anything occurring outside the normal time schedule to call the Ulster Police Department at (845)382-1111 to report the incident.
