On behalf of Cypress Creek Renewables, I invite you to attend an upcoming community open house for the Landau Solar project, a proposed solar farm at the former quarry site along State Route 32 in the Town of Ulster.

Cypress Creek is a developer and long-term owner/operator of solar farms across the U.S. and is the leader in 'local solar', projects that provide direct power to nearby residents. We partner with communities and utilities to provide widespread access to affordable, clean, and renewable energy.

The community meeting will be an opportunity for direct dialogue between the Ulster community and the team that will develop the Landau Solar project. As the Outreach Manager for the project, I look forward to meeting you and answering your questions about the proposed project.

In the meantime, we'd like to share a few highlights of the proposed Landau Solar farm:

- The solar farm will supply 6-megawatts of clean and renewable energy, enough to power 1,200-1,500 homes annually, contributing to the Town of Ulster's energy independence.
- Landau Solar will have very minimal environmental impact – the project is currently designated on previously disturbed land and the entire project will be fully enclosed by vegetation, to mitigate all visual impacts to the surrounding area.
- Pollinator friendly habitat will be planted to help increase crop yields of nearby agricultural fields and help reduce soil erosion and storm water runoff.
- Approximately 70 jobs will be created during construction and about \$36,000 in local tax revenue will be generated.
